



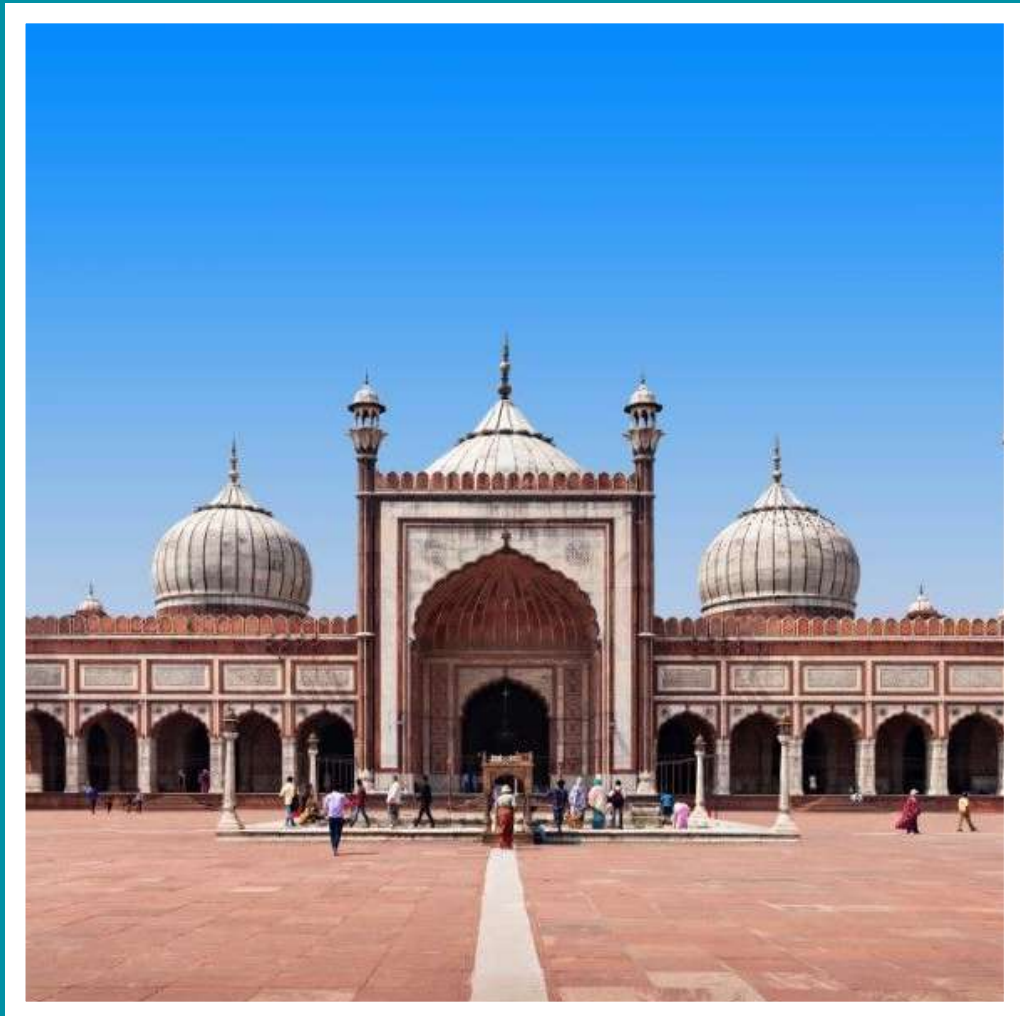

DAY 01: ARRIVE IN DELHI



- On arrival at New Delhi International airport, you will be welcomed by our local representative, and will be transferred to your hotel. Upon reaching the hotel, check into your rooms.
- Delhi has been the capital of several Indian Empires medieval period and a major city along the old trade routes. As the capital of India Delhi is the seat of administration and the monuments which tell the saga of a bygone era stand there.

Dinner and overnight stay in Delhi

DAY 2 : DELHI SIGHTSEEING

- Relish a good Indian breakfast at the hotel, and set out for sightseeing of Old Delhi and New Delhi.
- Visit the black and white onion dome and minarets of the Jama Masjid the most elegant mosque in India. The journey between the 2 will be on bicycle rickshaws- in convoy- through the narrow lanes of Chandini Chowk. Thereafter, visit the Red Fort
- Late afternoon proceed for New Delhi sightseeing, Drive down the main avenue the impressive Rajpath to the World War I memorial arch the India Gate and past the Presidential Palace, the Rashtrapati Bhavan and the secretariat buildings - the centre of all government activity. Visit the Qutub Minar 72 meters high and the ruins of Quwat-ul-Eslam (Light of Islam) Mosque and Delhi's most curious antique the un-corroded Iron Pillar

DAY 03: DELHI - MANDAWA (260kms/ 07 hrs)



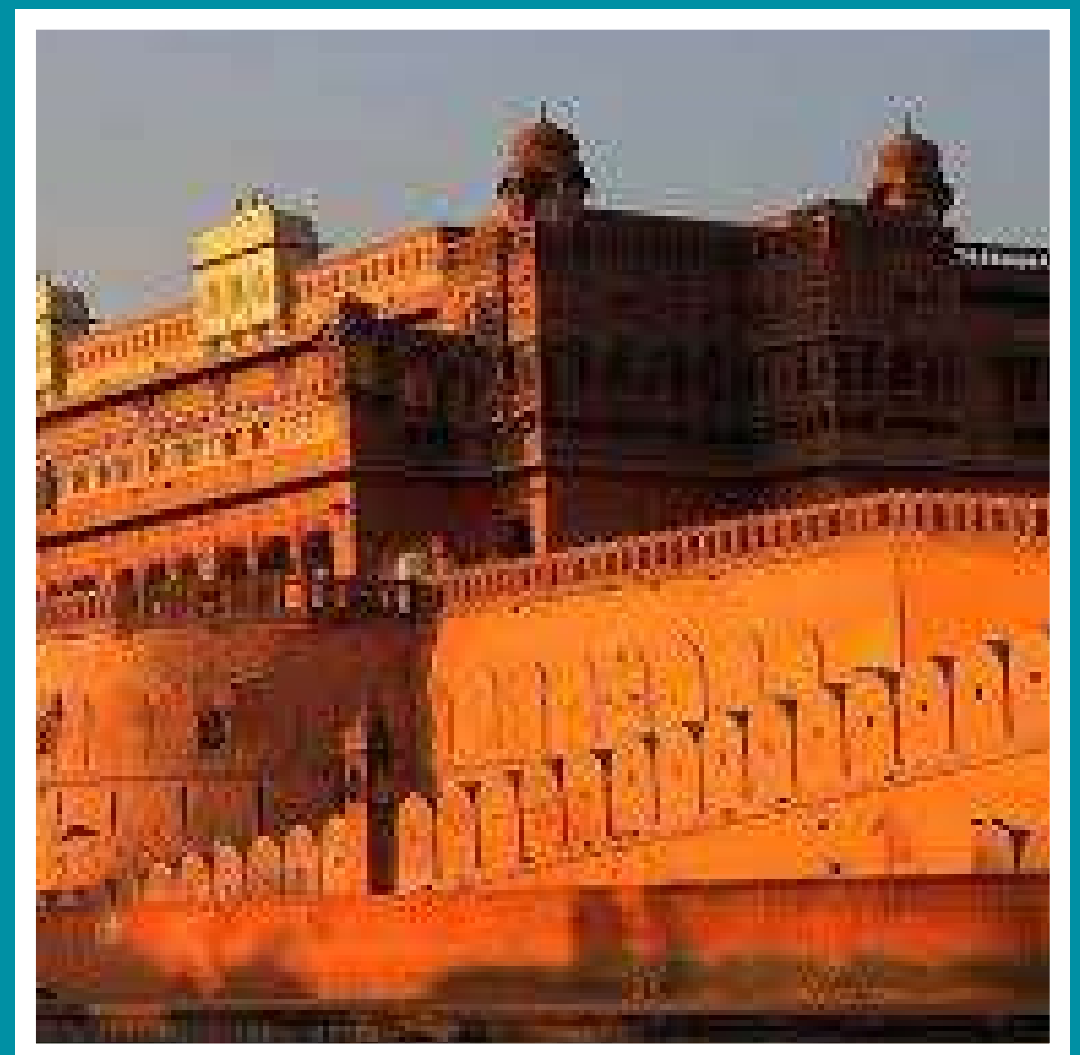
- After early breakfast at the hotel, proceed to Mandawa.
- Mandawa is a small town in the heart of Shekhawati region. The place is known not only for its havelis but also for its Fort Palace. The structure of the palace reminds of the cultural and social importance of this region in the past.
- Of the havelis, the most important are the Chokhani, Ladia, Binsidhar Newatia, and Gulab Rai Ladia Haveli.

Dinner and overnight stay in Mandawa.

DAY 4 : MANDAWA – BIKANER (200KMS/ 04 HRS)

- After breakfast at the hotel, check out of the hotel & proceed to Bikaner.
- Bikaner city lies on the northern point of the triangle of desert cities. While other cities of Rajasthan are rich in lakes and pleasure pavilions, Bikaner seems quite bare in that respect.
- In the afternoon, visit the Junagarh Fort followed by some sightseeing of Bikaner

DAY 05: BIKANER – JAISALMER (330kms/ 06 hrs)



- This morning, after breakfast check out of the hotel and proceed to Jaisalmer.
- Nothing else in India is remotely similar to Jaisalmer. Its desert fort, which resembles a gigantic sandcastle. There are many havelis which can be found elsewhere in Rajasthan, but nowhere are they quite as exquisite as in Jaisalmer. Even the humblest shops and houses display something of the Rajput love of the decorative arts.
- Check into your hotel on arrival.

Dinner & overnight stay in Jaisalmer.

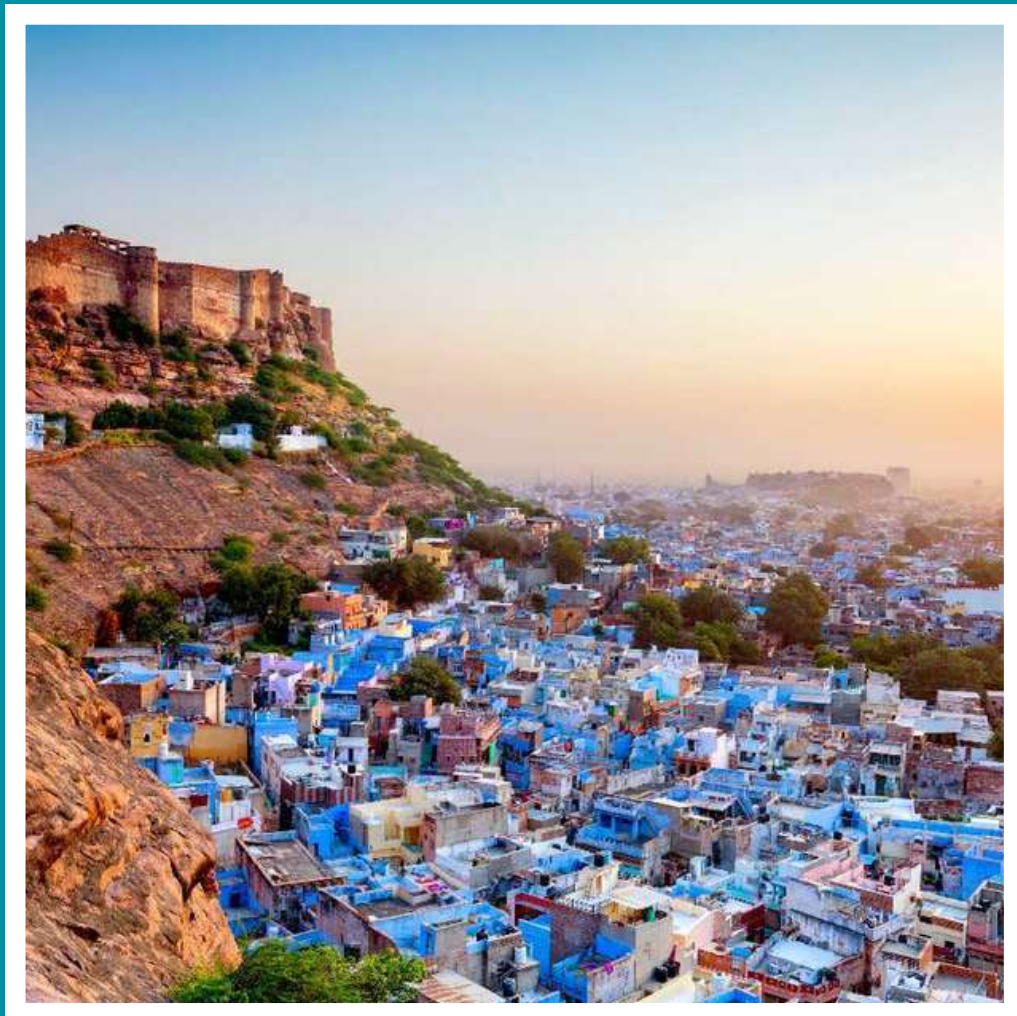
DAY 6 : JAISALMER SIGHTSEEING.

- After breakfast set out for sightseeing of Jaisalmer.
- Visit Jaisalmer Fort, Salim Singh ki Haveli, Patwon ki Haveli, Nathmalji ki Haveli, Bada Bagh and Gadisar Lake
- Later in the evening, proceed to the dune Enroute visit Kuldhara – a cursed village which was vacated overnight. On arrival at Sam Dunes, enjoy a camel ride at view the sunset over the dunes.
- Later, enjoy dinner along with a folkloric performance on the dunes

DAY 07: JAISALMER – JODHPUR (310kms/ 06hrs)

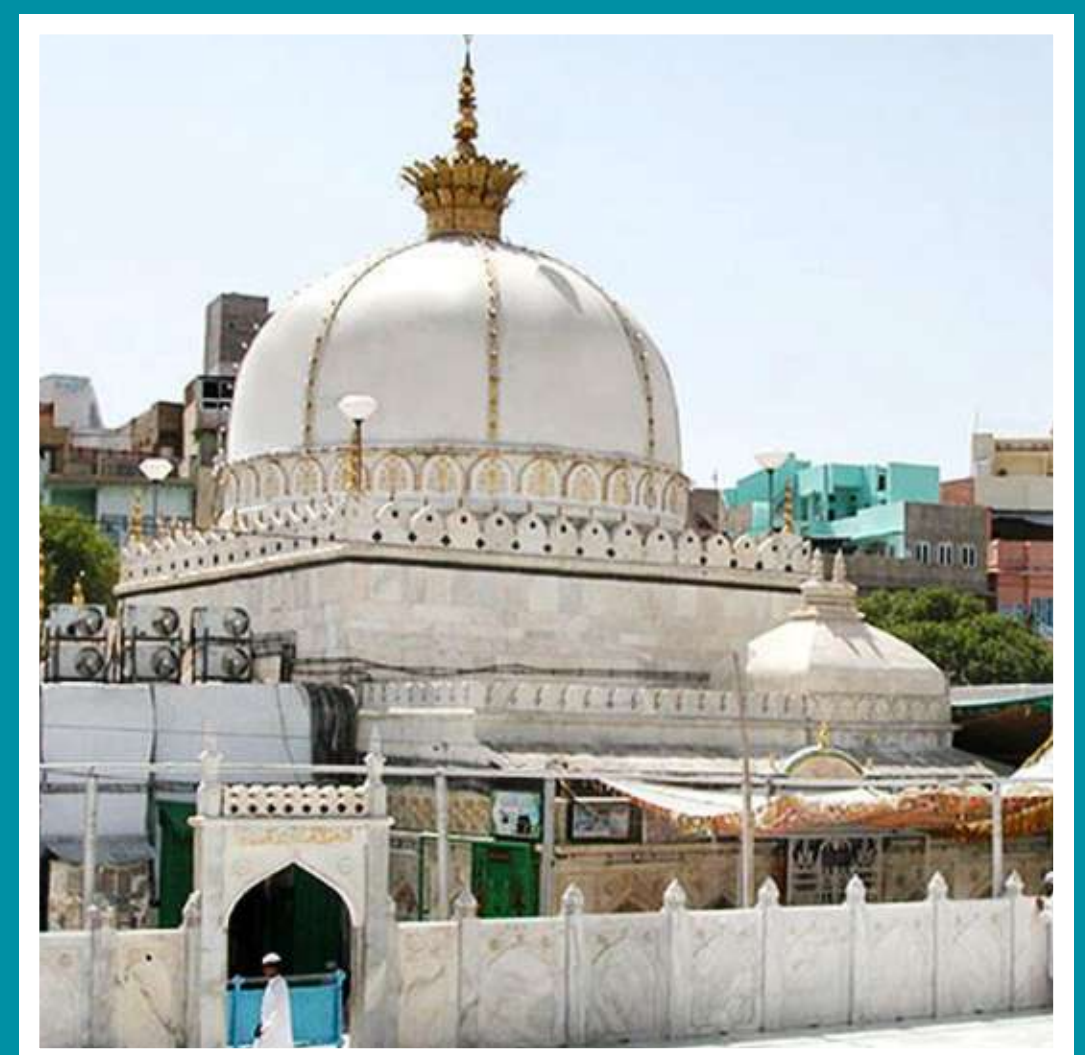


- After an early breakfast at the hotel, we proceed to Jodhpur enroute visiting Osian.
- Jodhpur is at the edge of the Thar desert and is the largest city in Rajasthan after Jaipur. Jodhpur is affectionately referred to as the 'Blue City' because of the indigo-coloured houses in the old town.
- After lunch, a brief tour of Jodhpur. Visit the Magnificent Meherangarh Fort, Jaswant Thada, Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum & Clock Tower.

DAY 8 : JODHPUR – JAIPUR (330KMS/ 07HRS)

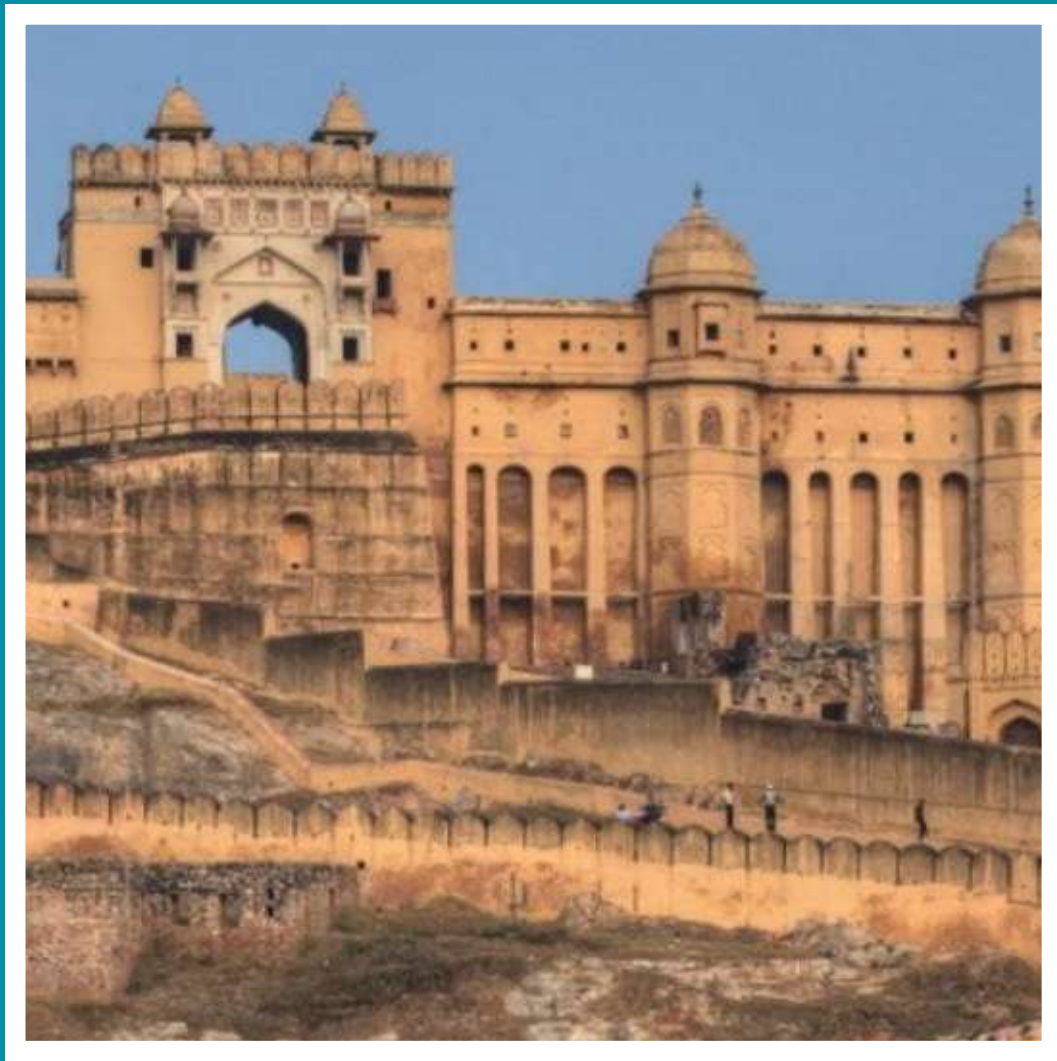
- After an early breakfast, checkout of the hotel & proceed towards Jaipur.
- Stop at Ajmer enroute for sightseeing of Ajmer, famous for Khwaja Mohinuddin Salim Chisti Dargah.
- Note – pax will have to wear appropriate clothing. Men /Women in full length trouser/skirt & sleeved top/shirt. Sleeveless shirts & knee length skirts are not permissible. Pax will have to cover their head with scarf/stole when entering the premises.
- Continue your journey to Jaipur. On arrival, check into your hotel

DAY 09: JAIPUR

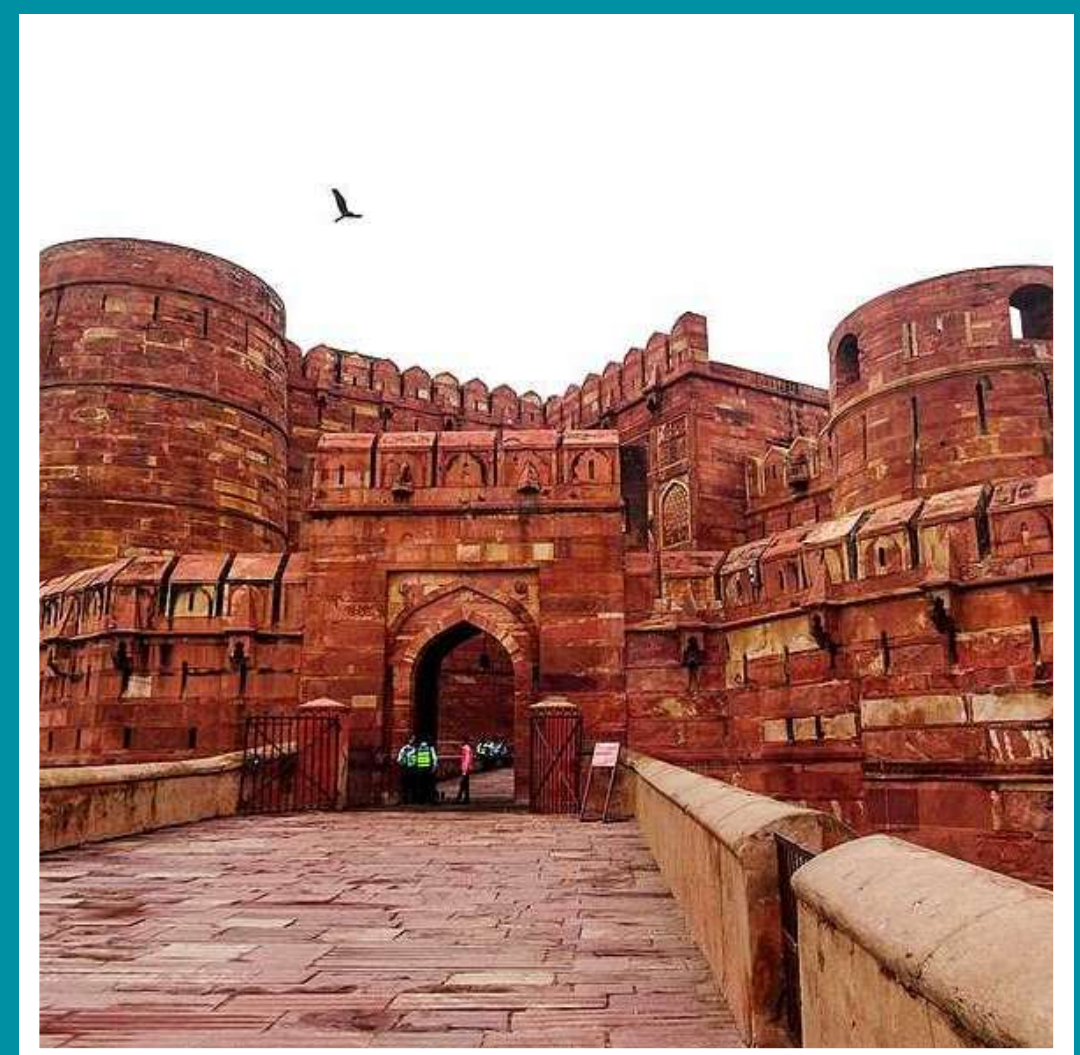


- After breakfast at the hotel, visit Amber Fort. At Amber Fort you climb up the fort on a jeep or an elephant's back like the Maharajas and visit the Amber Palace of the Kuchchawa rulers.
- After lunch, go for a city tour of Jaipur.
- Jaipur is popularly known as the 'Pink City' because of the pink sandstone used in the buildings of the old walled city.
- Visit the Hawa Mahal, Jantar Mantar, Badi Chaupar, Birla Temple, City Palace, Johari Bazaar,.
- Late in the afternoon, visit a local home for high tea. Here you will be able to interact with the locals and get to know about their way of life.

Dinner and overnight stay in Jaipur.

DAY 10 : JAIPUR – AGRA (248 / 05HRS)

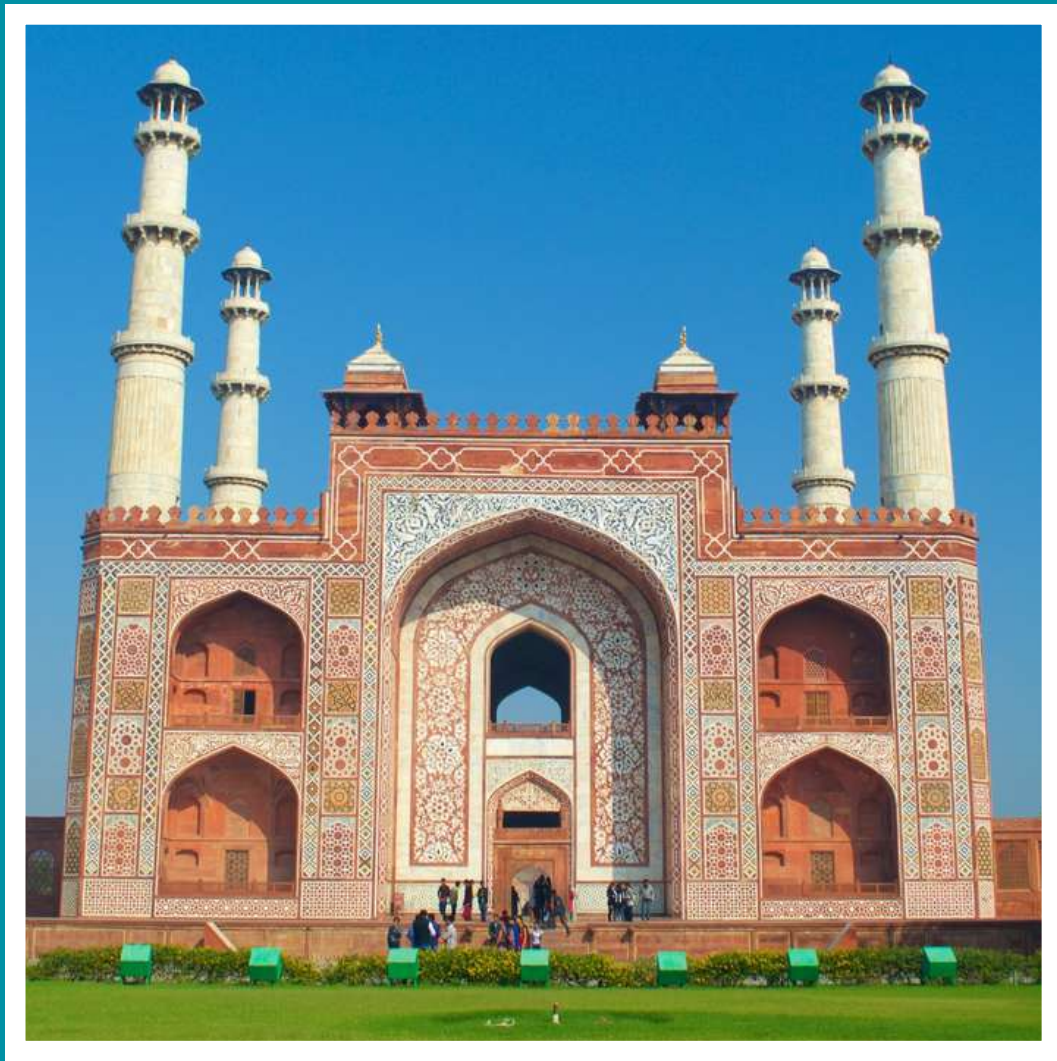
- After a leisurely breakfast, leave to Agra enroute visiting Fatehpur Sikri
- Continue towards Agra & check in at hotel.
- Afternoon visit Agra Fort (Red Fort), where Emperor Shahjahan spent his last few years of life.
- In the evening, set out for a sightseeing tour of Agra. Visit the world famous Taj Mahal – (closed on Friday) The magnificent monument built by Emperor Shah Jehan in the memories of his wife Mumtaz Mahal. It is also one of the seven wonders of the world.

DAY 11 : AGRA - DELHI (204 / 04hrs)



- After a good breakfast and check out from the hotel & proceed to Delhi.
- Continue to Delhi visiting Sikandara – where lies Emperor Akbar's Tomb and Mathura– Birth place of Lord Krishna.
- After lunch continue to Delhi. On arrival in Delhi, check in at hotel. Evening at leisure.

Dinner & overnight stay in Delhi.

DAY 12 : DELHI DEPARTURE

- After breakfast, Check out from the hotel. You will be transferred to Delhi International Airport to board flight at TBA to your home country.
